



Walk Registration Frequently Asked Questions



Do I need to register all my children, even if they are in a stroller and not raising money?

- ❖ *Yes, for two reasons, JDRF requires that all walkers sign the waiver and JDRF Orange County would like to account for all walkers joining us.*

Do I need to register if I don't have any donations to turn in?

- ❖ *If you have registered online and checked the event waiver signed box, then you do not need to register. If you have not signed the event waiver, then yes, register.*

Do I need to fill out the entire walk envelope?

- ❖ *Yes, you need to fill out the entire walk envelope to ensure that you are credited properly on your fundraising page.*

How can I get a walk t-shirt?

- ❖ *Each walker that raises \$100 will receive a raffle ticket when they register that can be taken to the T-shirt table and turned in to receive their 2009 Walk to Cure Diabetes shirt.*

When is the deadline to turn in donations to qualify for Walk Awards?

- ❖ *December 31, 2009 is the deadline to be eligible for Walk Awards which will be held in January 2010 and also to qualify for the 2 year two year Mazda 3i sedan lease.*

What if I get donations after the Walk Awards December 31 deadline?

- ❖ *The Orange County chapter can accept walk donations until June 30, 2010. Send your donations to the Orange County office. Your donations will not be eligible for Walk Awards; however, they will help find a cure for diabetes.*

What if I receive donations after the walk, what do I do with them?

- ❖ *Send all your post walk donations to the JDRF Orange County office and they will be credited to your walk fundraising page.*

How do I make sure I get my prize?

- ❖ *On your walker envelope, in the middle area you will see a PRIZE SELECTION section. Please mark "Send me my prize" and then be sure to mark which prize you would like.*

What if I forget to mark what prize I want?

- ❖ *You can call the JDRF Orange County office and speak with a staff member and they will select the prize you want.*

When will I get my prize?

- ❖ *You will receive your prize six to eight weeks after the walk.*

What if I don't want a prize and I qualified for one?

- ❖ *On your walker envelope in the middle area under PRIZE SELECTION there is a spot for you to mark "Do not send prize – use my full donation to find a cure!"*
